DAVIS, CHARLES LESLIE March 30, 1887-May 4, 1943

"Another of the World's Greatest Noblemen has gone". This one of his intimate friends spoke in reference to the death of Charley Davis, for about 30 years a resident of the Slater community.

Charles Leslie Davis was born in Missouri March 30, 1887, and came to Wyoming when a young man. He talked little of himself or his early life, nor the trouble (vascular tumor) from which he suffered for a long time before death claimed him in Memorial Hospital in Cheyenne, Tuesday, May 4.

In the early part of March, Mr. Davis left Slater intending to go to Oregon to visit two of his children, but arriving in Cheyenne became too ill to go on and entered the hospital in hopes of regaining his health.

He is survived by four children: Darrell Leslie who is overseas; Delmar Charles, at Fort Bragg, North Carolina; Veda Lois, Independence, Oregon and Francis Marion, Unity, Oregon. His wife, Gladys Livingston Davis, died 8 years ago.

Brief funeral services were held in Denver where his body was cremated. The ashes will be held awaiting instructions from his children.
