

DAVIS, GLADYS NEOLA LIVINGSTON

November 11, 1895-October 19, 1935

Mrs. Chas. Davis, well known Bordeaux lady, passed away in Wheatland Wednesday morning at 6 o'clock. Mrs. Davis had been in poor health a number of years.

Funeral services will be held from the Methodist church Friday afternoon at one thirty. Rev. Irvine C. Noyce will preach the funeral. Interment will take place in the Wheatland cemetery with the Copley Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.

Gladys Neola Davis was born in Nebraska November 11, 1895 and came to this section of Wyoming about 15 years ago.

Besides her husband, she is survived by four children, Darrell, Delmer, Vera and Frances; her father, J.R. Livingston, one sister, Mrs. Richard Butner of Dwyer, besides a host of other relatives.

For many years Mrs. Davis has been a capable and prompt correspondent from the Bordeaux community for THE TIMES. She took an active interest in the happenings of her community and made it a point to get them recorded in the paper. Even while confined to her sick bed a few years ago, she gathered the news from her visitors and wrote them down. While on her deathbed this week, she recorded a few items and had them sent to THE TIMES. They were published in the first run of the paper a day prior to her demise.
