December 24, 1880-March 23, 1948

Jesse Davis, 68, died suddenly of a heart attack around 3:30 p.m. Tuesday, March 23, while he was at his work at the Foster Lumber Company. He had been a resident of Wheatland for the past 44 years.

He was born December 24, 1880 in Decatur, Iowa. He was a Past Grand of the I.O.O.F. lodge and was a 32nd degree Mason.
