

DAVIS, MINERVA JANE
April 8, 1865-October 22, 1950

A woman well known and beloved in this community for many years died at New Plymouth, Ida., at the home of her daughter, Mrs. M. Watson, Oct.22. She was Mrs. Minerva Jane Davis who lived in Wheatland from 1914 to 1946. She was born in Indiana April 8, 1865. She is the widow of the late George P.
