

DAVIS, NETTIE MAE PHELPS  
May 28, 1894- June 28, 1977

Funeral services were held Thursday, June 30 for Nettie Mae Davis, age 83, at the United Methodist Church with Rev. William Jacoby officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland Cemetery. She died Tuesday, June 28, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital after an extended illness.

She was born in Eaton, Colorado, to Mr. and Mrs. W.W. Phelps on May 28, 1894. She moved with her parents to Wyoming in 1896 where her parents ranched on the Sybille, now known as the Radical Ranch. She married J. Ezra Davis on December 4, 1912 at her parents home. They moved to the Fish Creek area in 1915 and ranched there until 1919, at which time they moved to Wheatland where they stayed.

Mrs. Davis was a member of the United Methodist Church. She was also an active member of the Rebecca Lodge No. 16 for 45 years, and held numerous offices in the Lodge and in the Past Noble Grand Club.

She is survived in death by her husband J. Ezra Davis; three sisters, Cora Runyan of Wheatland, Eva Napier of Spokane, Wash., and Dora Braketa of Riverton; also several nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by two brothers; Ottis and Kelly Phelps and one sister, Laura Runyan.

Serving as pallbearers were Eddie Welty, Fritz Merback, Herb Percy, Gordon Drury, Dale Wright and Darrell Hartung.

A memorial has been established to the Rebecca Lodge. These funds are to be used for a charitable cause which will be determined by the lodge. Schrader-Prell Funeral Home was in charge of arrangements.
