

DAVIS, RUSSELL JENKINS  
March 25, 1904-May 19, 1973

Russell J. Davis, 69, passed away on Saturday, May 19, 1973, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital following an extended illness. Mr. Davis was in the trucking business, but was retired at the time of his death.

Mr. Davis was born in Carroll, Nebraska, March 25, 1904. Sixteen years later, he moved to Wheatland where he married his wife, the former Wilma Kuehner, on June 10, 1920. He was affiliated with the Methodist Church and was a member of the IOOF.
