

DAWSON, CLAUDE CHRISTOPHER

July 17, 1889-October 26, 1948

Funeral services were held last Monday at the Christian church for Claude Dawson, 59, who died October 26, at the home of his sister-in-law, Mrs. O.M. Blake at Riverbank, Calif.

Claude Christopher Dawson was born July 17, 1889 at Denver, the eldest of four children. He was united in marriage with Cora Herndon on February 28, 1912 in Worth County, Mo.

Mr. Dawson was a dealer in livestock and was a member of the Christian church and the Modern Woodmen of America.

Survivors include his wife, Cora, one daughter, Mrs. Virginia E. Barrett of Rawlins and one son, Harold O. Dawson of Greenville, Calif.; four grandchildren, Cora Lee and Freddie Barrett and JoAnn and Lois Jean Dawson. His parents, sister and two brothers preceded him in death.
