

DAWSON, NELLIE ANDERSON BROWN

January 26, 1867-November 23, 1944

Mrs. George Dawson, 77, resident of Platte county since 1916, died at her home about 7:30 p.m. Thursday, November 23 following an extended illness. Funeral services were held Monday in the Christian church with the Rev. Charles E. Hannan of Cheyenne officiating. Mrs. Lenora Judge, Roy Purcell, Lowell Clark and Eileen Clark, accompanied by Mrs. Bart Bellis, sang.

Nellie Anderson Brown Dawson was born January 26, 1867 in Isadora, Mo. to Metta and Rinaldo Brown. She was united in marriage to George Sherman Dawson in Denver, Mo. and to this union four children were born, two preceding her in death. Her husband died in 1939. She was affiliated with the Christian church and was an active member as long as her health permitted.

She is survived by two sons, Claude and Harry Dawson; one brother, Frank Brown of Montana; one sister, Mrs. Anna Goff of Grant City, Mo.; a half brother and two half sisters; four granddaughters, three grandsons, and six great grandchildren.

Pallbearers included M.A. Thrasher, Clarence Grey, Roy Purcell, Roger Mills, Bart Bellis, and Charles Woolsey. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery beside her husband.
