



Gladys Pauline Day



August 26, 1918 - January 9, 2002

Memorial services for Gladys Pauline Day, 83, were held January 12, at 11 a.m. at the First Christian Church in Wheatland, with Father Joel Dingman officiating. Inurnment was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Gladys died Wednesday, Jan. 9, at the Platte County Memorial Nursing Home in Wheatland.

Gladys was born in August 26, 1918, in Presque Isle, Maine, the daughter of Ellery and Grace (Webber) Sloat. She married Allen Rosco Day on Sept. 27, 1940, in Freeport Maine. They moved to

Wyoming in 1950. Gladys owned and operated the Cowboy Cafe in Wheatland and later worked as a cook at the Wheatland Country Club and the Big A Restaurant. She worked at the Platte County Museum for awhile. Gladys loved her bingo and crossword puzzles.
