Funeral services were held Tuesday at 2:00 p.m. from the Schrader Chapel for Sherman Jared Dearinger, 64, who passed away January 11, 1958 after an extended illness at the Harry Dearinger residence. Rev. Daniel T. Winger officiated at the last rites.
