

# Genevieve Evelyn Deener

*December 14, 1920 – February 11, 2008*

A funeral service for Genevieve Evelyn Deemer, 87, was conducted on Tuesday, Feb. 19, 2008, at the Colyer Funeral Home in Torrington, Wyo., with Glenn Sparks and Joe Kluczewich officiating. Interment followed in the Wheatland Cemetery at Wheatland, Wyo.
