Funeral services for Maxine DeGroot, 66, of Scottsbluff, Neb., who died April 15, 1987 at the Scottsbluff hospital, were held April 20 at 11:30 a.m. at the Jolliffe Funeral Home in Scottsbluff with Pastor James E. Rowe officiating. Graveside services were held April 20 at 3:00 p.m. at the Wheatland Cemetery.

A memorial has been established to the First Baptist Church in Scottsbluff.

She was born Dec. 2, 1920 in Guernsey, where she grew up and graduated from high school. She attended business

college in Denver, and then began working for an oil company researching land abstracts throughout the midwest.
