

DEVENY, WAYNE EUGENE  
January 7, 1963-May 5, 1969

Tragedy struck swiftly Monday morning at the Delmar DeVeny home northwest of Wheatland when 6 year old Wayne DeVeny crawled inside a clothes dryer and closed the door, starting the machine. His mother had just gone outside to get the mail at the mail box when the accident occurred.

Wayne was pronounced dead on arrival at Platte County Memorial Hospital where he was taken. Death resulted from multiple injuries received in the revolving dryer.

The DeVeny's reside at the Woody May ranch. No inquest is planned.

Services for young Wayne E. DeVeny, age 6, will be held Friday, May 6, at the First Baptist Church. Doug Neumann will officiate and burial will be at the Wheatland Cemetery. Pallbearers will be Buddy Wilson, Woody May, Albert Goertz and Don VanPelt.

Wayne DeVeny was born at Platte County Memorial Hospital on Jan. 7, 1963. He died on Monday, May 5<sup>th</sup>, on the Woody May Farm.

Survivors include his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Delmar DeVeny; one brother, Dean DeVeny; two sisters, Wanda and Peggy DeVeny, all at home; and his grandparents, Mr. and Mrs. Vern Vandiver of Casper and Mrs. Bonnie DeVeny of Chugwater.
