

Sheila Diane Dietz

April 15, 1933 - October 26, 2001

Funeral services for Sheila Diane Dietz, 68, were held Monday, October 25 at the United Church of Christ in Wheatland, with Rev. Jeff Barton officiating. Cremation took place following the service.

Mrs. Dietz died Friday, October 26 at the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland.

Sheila was born April 15, 1933 in Wheatland, the daughter of Ralph and Myrna (Adams) Hall. She was reared and educated in Albany County at the Cuba Ranch up Palmer Canyon until high school. She attended and graduated from Wheatland High School in 1950. Sheila married Larry Mylet and for a time lived in Seattle, Wash., but later returned to Wheatland. After Larry's death in 1964, she married Tim Mylet and they lived in Wheatland and Taos, N.M.; and later divorced. She attended Colorado College in Colorado Springs, the University of Wyoming in Laramie and Colorado State University in Ft. Collins; she was six hours from having her degree. On December 17, 1984, she married William "Dempsey" Dietz in Wheatland. While at Colorado College, she was a member of the Kappa Kappa Gamma sorority, and she was a past member of the Wyoming Cowbelles and the Stockgrower's Association. She was a member of the P.E.O. Sisterhood and held the distinction of being crowned Miss Rodeo Platte County in 1953. Sheila was a viracious

reader and was a historian of the area and family genealogy. She was a collector of many things and had donated some of her collectibles to the Laramie Peak Museum.

She is survived by her husband, Dempsey Dietz of Wheatland; five children, Monica Mylet of Lincoln, Neb., Samantha Mylet of Cheyenne, Derrick Dietz, Diane Martin and Darcy Woods all of Casper; ten grandchildren, Yasha Hartberg of College Station, TX, Molly Hartberg-Cook of Gillette, Elizabeth, Stephen, and Amanda Mondragon of Cheyenne, Bridger Martin, Danielle Dietz, Morgan Woods, McKenzie Woods, and Jacob Dietz all of Casper; and three great-grandchildren, Matthew, Anthony, and Logan Hartberg of Gillette.

Sheila was preceded in death by her parents; first husband, Larry Mylet on May 29, 1964; and three sons, Tom Mylet in infancy, and Hugh Mylet and Colin Mylet on May 29, 1964.

Serving as pallbearers will be Derrick Dietz, Don Evans, Josh Evans, David Windmeier, Newt Russell, and Butch Russell.
