

DODGE, EVA LYDIA DOVER  
December 31, 1887-April 5, 1967

Pioneer Platte county resident, Eva Lydia Dodge, succumbed to a brief illness at Platte County Memorial Hospital April 5, 1967. A lifetime resident of the area, Mrs. Dodge was born in Cheyenne Dec. 21, 1887, and was an active member of the OES, Daughters of the Nile, Laramie Peak Cow-Belles, Wyoming Stock Growers Assn., and the Reform L.D.S. church.

Many friends of long standing share the loss with the remaining family members; a son, George Dodge of Rock River; two daughters, Mrs. James (Margaret) Laycock and Mrs. Arch (June) Akers, both of Wheatland; a sister, Mrs. Leslie Atkinson of Garrett; six grandchildren, 2 step-grandsons and four great grandchildren. Her husband, Thomas B. Dodge, preceded her in death on August 12, 1963.
