Mrs. Clarice Doran died at the hospital Tuesday morning from acute dilatation of the heart with which she was stricken four weeks ago while working as a waitress at the Globe hotel. She was but 20 years of age and had been only married a short time before coming to Wheatland to work, two weeks before her sudden and fatal illness. She was a very pretty girl, of fine character, and a communicant of the Catholic church. Poverty resulting from illness and other misfortune compelled her to seek employment here and her husband has been working at Greeley. A sister came from Price, Utah, a few days ago, but she too is without means. To prevent her from being buried by the county, a collection was taken up among sympathetic citizens and she'll be given a Christian burial today. Thru her few weeks of illness, which was pronounced hopeless from the first, she was patient and grateful for the care given her and endeared herself to the entire hospital corps.
