DOTY, SILAS October 1, 1847-September 26, 1911

A message was received from Cheyenne Tuesday morning telling of the death of S. Doty which occurred in a hospital at that place during the morning.

Mr. Doty was taken sick with heart trouble at Wheatland during the summer, and was on his way to the home of a sister in Michigan when he had taken worse at Cheyenne where he has been in a hospital the past two months.

Mr. Doty was one of the pioneer residents of this section, owning a fine ranch in the Goshen Hole country until about ten years ago when he moved to Wheatland to reside. He was one of our most prominent citizens having been one of the stockholders and incorporators of the State Bank of Wheatland. He was also interested in a number of other business enterprises, as he had accumulated a competency during the years he had devoted to the ranching business.

Mrs. Doty passed away some four or five years ago, since that time Mr. Doty has spent considerable time at the homes of his sisters in Kansas and Michigan, although he still claimed Wheatland as his home. The deceased was probably in the neighborhood of 63 or 64 years of age. Regular obituary notice will be printed next week.

The remains will be shipped to Wheatland and funeral services will be held at the Congregational church on Friday afternoon at one o'clock, interment to be made in the Wheatland cemetery.
