DOUGHERTY, THOMAS F. January 10, 1859-December 12, 1928

The many friends of Thomas F. Dougherty, another of Wheatland's long time residents, were shocked to learn of his sudden death Monday morning, December 10th. Mr. Dougherty had apparently been in good health up to last week and was seen around town by his friends and was suddenly taken ill with pneumonia, which with a weak heart, caused his death.

Thomas F. Dougherty was born in Warren county, Ill., and was 69 years and 11 months of age at the time of his death. He came to Wheatland about 20 years ago from Iowa, settling on a farm west of town and has made his home there and in Wheatland ever since. He sold his farm several years ago and came to Wheatland where he lives as a retired farmer.

Mr. Dougherty was a bachelor and his only living relatives are several nieces, nephews and cousins. Mrs. Abner Clark, a niece, who lives west of Wheatland is the only relative living in this part of the country. Funeral services were held from the Wheatland Catholic church this morning, Thursday, at 10 o'clock and burial was made in the Wheatland cemetery with the Watson Mortuary in charge.
