

DOUGLAS, GEORGE HAROLD
December 23, 1946-January 5, 2000

Funeral services for George Harold Douglas, 53, were held Saturday, January 8, 2002, at 10 a.m. at the Platte Funeral Chapel in Wheatland with Pastor Lynn Nikkel of the Memorial Baptist officiating. Internment was in the Wheatland Cemetery.

Mr. Douglas died of natural causes at his home in Cheyenne on Wednesday, January 5, 2000.
