

Dick Allen Douglass 1936 to 1997

Graveside services and interment for Dick Allen Douglass, 60, were held Friday, Jan. 31 at 2 p.m. at the Wheatland Cemetery, Pastor Gordon Swedberg officiating.

Mr. Douglass died Tuesday, Jan. 28, in the emergency room of the Platte County Memorial Hospital in Wheatland.
