Warren Ward "Brownie", Douglass 1904 to 1996

Funeral services for Warren Ward "Brownie" Douglass, age 92, were held Monday, July 15 at the Platte Funeral Chapel in Wheatland, Wyo., with Pastor Gordon Swedberg officiating. Interment followed in the Wheatland Cemetery.
