

DOWER, JAMES  
January 6, 1892-October 24, 1951

James Dower, 59, longtime resident of Wheatland, died October 24 in Fitzsimmons hospital at Denver after an illness of several months.

Dower, who was employed at Sunrise mines until 1937, moved to Wheatland at that time and operated a pool hall until two years ago. He had recently been associated with his son, Bud, in the floral business.

He was a member of the V.F.W., the Odd Fellows lodge, and was a veteran of World War I.

Survivors include his wife, Garnet; two sons, Bud of Wheatland and James L. of Fargo, N.D.; one sister, Mrs. Jane Nancarrow of Klamath Falls, Ore., and two grandchildren.

The body was brought to Wheatland today, and funeral arrangements, in charge of Schraders, were incomplete at noon.
