

DREW, MABEL CECILIA
December 20, 1901-February 3, 1917

Mabel Cecilia Drew, daughter of Mr. and Mrs. A.J. Drew of Bordeaux, died at the Wheatland hospital early Saturday morning from double pneumonia. She was born at Lima, Ohio, Dec. 20, 1901, and came to this state in 1913 with her parents who have since resided on a homestead near Bordeaux. About a week before her death she was stricken with pneumonia and after a few days was brought to the Wheatland hospital for treatment, but the illness was of such a serious nature and had so far developed that she failed to respond to medical treatment. Besides her father and mother, she leaves three sisters, three brothers and a host of friends to mourn the untimely death of a bright and lovable girl.

A beautiful flower has been plucked from earth's garden, but we believe not to wither, but not to be transplanted in God's heavenly garden where there is no more death.

As the fragrance of the flower remains after it has been severed from the stem, so will the memory of the character of this young lady remain with her friends long after her body is layed to rest.
