

DRUBE, WILHELMENA ABRAMOKI

June 12, 1859-August 18, 1924

Mrs. Wilhelmena Drube, a well known and highly respected resident of Wheatland for 13 years, passed away early in the morning of Monday, August 18, at the Wheatland hospital, at the age of 65, following an illness of many months.

She was born in Koenigsburg, German June 12, 1859, and came to the United States at the age of 17 years. She came to Wheatland in 1911 from Madison, Minn. She was married to Fritz Drube on Oct. 25, 1879. Ten children were born of this union, of whom, one, George Drube, died Oct. 22, 1922.

The children that are living are Mrs. J. Merback, Mrs. Hugo Lange, Mrs. Oscar Swan, Mrs. William Ryff, Fritz Drube, Jr., Lydia Drube and Ernest Drube, all of Wheatland, Mrs. W.H. Rounds of Drumheller, Canada; Mrs. William Komis of Malta, Mont.

The funeral was held at 2 p.m. from the local Methodist church, Rev H.L. Schuetz of Cheyenne officiating, and interment took place in the Wheatland cemetery.
