

DRUCKER, HENRY C.  
May 25, 1890-January 14, 1966

Last rites for Henry C. Drucker, well-known retired farmer, were held at the Schrader Chapel on Jan. 17 at 2:00 p.m. with Mr. Dale Scheffler officiating. Interment was in the local cemetery.

Mr. Drucker was born in Exeter, Nebr. on May 25, 1890 and was married to Anna M. Boeka on Feb. 22, 1911 at Seward, Nebr. The Druckers moved from Mitchell, Nebr. to the Wheatland area in 1927. Death occurred at the Platte County Memorial Hospital on January 14, 1966 after a two week confinement.
