

DUFFY, ROLAND ELMER
April 8, 1883-March 23, 1940

Roland E. Duffy, died Saturday morning following an illness of only six days which was preceded by a heart attack.

Mr. Duffy was born April 8, 1883 at Maryville, Mo., and passed away at Wheatland Saturday, March 23, 1940 at the age of 56 years 11 months and 15 days.

He was united in marriage to Emma Graham, August 23, 1910 at Kansas City, Mo. To this union were born three children, Mary Margaret, now Mrs. W. R. King of Laramie, Helen and Ted, both of whom are attending the university at Laramie.

Besides his wife and children, Mr. Duffy is survived by one sister, Mrs. C. L. Thompson and brother Glen both of Wheatland and another brother H.L. who lives in Laramie.

Mr. Duffy was a member of Ravenwood, Mo. Masonic Lodge No. 41 and was active in the Methodist church in Wheatland.

The Duffys moved to Dwyer 25 years ago where he managed a store. Later the family moved to Wheatland and for the past 10 years he was associated with the Co-Op store. He was elected manager of the store only a few months before his death.

Funeral services will be held Tuesday afternoon at 2:30 with Rev. Doughty officiating, assisted by Rev. Flenner. Watson and Dennis are in charge of arrangements.
