

DUNGEY, JOHN FRANCIS
1887-February 5, 1944

Funeral services for John Francis Dungey, son of Mrs. Mary Dungey of Sunrise, were held Thursday, February 10, at 2 p.m., in the family home in Sunrise with Rev. J.W. Wright officiating. Burial was made in the family plot in the Wheatland cemetery and arrangements were in charge of the Schrader Funeral Home.

Mr. Dungey, age 66, was born in Republic, Mich., and came to Wyoming in 1905. He was employed by the C.F. & I. railroad as an engineer at the time of his death, February 5 in the Fairacre hospital in Scottsbluff, Nebr., after a short illness. He was a member of the Odd Fellows lodge at Wheatland and a brother of the Locomotive and Engineer Fireman.

Besides his mother, Mrs. Dungey, he is survived by a sister Mrs. Mae Chandler of Chicago.
