Graveside services for Louise Dunham, 75, were held Monday, May 1, 1989 at 2 p.m. at the Wheatland Cemetery with Pastor Chet Shaw of the First Christian Church officiating.

Mrs. Dunham died Thursday, April 27, 1989 at her home in Wheatland.
