

Leo E. Du Vall

January 24, 1918 – July 18, 2006

Memorial services for Leo E. Du Vall, 88, will be held at 4 p.m. on Saturday, July 29 at his home in Veteran. Leo died at Community Hospital in Torrington on July 18, 2006, and cremation has taken place at his request.

Leo was born January 24, 1918, in Chugwater, to William and Bessie (Blumer) Du Vall. He grew up in Wheatland and worked on a sheep ranch in Chugwater for several years.

He was a police officer in Wheatland for a short time before he drove a milk delivery truck in the area.

Leo married Sylvia Jessie on November 15, 1952 in Torrington. He became a meat cutter in Torrington, Idaho, and Montana. In Montana he

started his own post and pole cutting business in the Hamilton area. He retired from this in the early 1980's due to ill health.

Leo loved hunting, fishing, and the mountains. He enjoyed his livestock, which he had around him most of his life.

Leo is survived by his wife Sylvia of Veteran; three daughters, Nancy Garness and husband Dale of Hamilton, Katherine Barnes and husband Kenneth of Torrington, and Caroline Hale and husband Neil of Casper; two sons, Clarence "Larry" Du Vall and companion Debbie, and Clyde Du Vall and wife Tammy, all of Wheatland; two sisters, Mable Snook and husband Delbert of Wheatland, and Betty Painter of Torrington; 10 grandchildren; and 10 great-grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents; two sisters, Mary and Bonnie; two brothers, Leonard and Russell; one son Jerry; and a daughter Myrna.
