June 22, 1918-June 2002

Funeral services for Nola Louise Hale, 84, were held Tuesday, July 2, 2002, at the United Methodist Church in Wheatland, Wyoming, with Reverend Les Ludlam officiating. Cremation will take place after the service and inurnment will be in the Wheatland Cemetery at a later date.

Mrs. Hale was born on June 22, 1918, in Lincoln, Nebraska, the daughter of Frank and Emma (Wengert) Gillam.
