

FABRICIUS, MOLLIE MITCHELL  
December 11, 1908-February 23, 1951

Mollie (Mrs. Ferdinard) Fabricius, 42, died February 23, in a local hospital, where she had been taken six days previously.

Born December 11, 1908 in Ft. Collins, she resided there until six years ago, when the family moved to Ault, Colo. They have lived a mile and a quarter west of Wheatland, on the Farm to Market road for the past four years.
