

FERGUSON, CHARLES H.

?-August 31, 1947

Charles H. Ferguson, about 65, employed by the Allred-Enix construction company, was found dead about 1:30 p.m. Sunday in the old Roller mill warehouse just north of the Laramie hotel by Scotty McDonald, another worker for the company.

Ferguson was last seen by his co-workers about 6 a.m. that morning. An autopsy was performed and cause of death was attributed to a heart condition. No next of kin were located, according to County Coroner Ted Schrader, although Ferguson's last known previous address was ascertained to be El Paso, Tex.

Graveside services were held this afternoon for Ferguson, the Rev. Hoadley officiating. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery.
