

FERGUSON, JOSEPH V.
January 1, 1894-April 22, 1961

Joseph V. Ferguson passed away April 22 at a Cheyenne hospital following an extended illness. He had resided here since 1912, coming to Wheatland from Denver, Colo. where he was born on January 1, 1894 to Thomas J. and Frances Murray Ferguson.

A farmer by occupation, he and his sister, Veronica had also operated the Ferguson Corner Station for a number of years. He was affiliated with the Catholic Church, Grange, Knights of Columbus, American Legion and was a veteran of World War I.

Funeral services were held at the St. Patrick's Catholic church at 10:30 Wednesday morning with Rev. Father Leonard Wren in charge. Burial was in the Wheatland cemetery with William Howard, William Burzlaff, William Klein, Don Olson, Virgil Vogt and Alan Weber serving as pallbearers.

He is survived by four sisters, Mrs. Agnes Mullen and Miss Veronica Ferguson, both of Wheatland; Mrs. Loretto Ross, Cody and Mrs. Rose Foy, Glendo and two brothers, Leo J. of Laramie and Francis J. Denver.
