

10-30 Florence Short Fish 1994

Graveside services for Florence Short Fish, 94, were held Tuesday, November 1, 1994, at 10:30 a.m. at the Wheatland Cemetery in Wheatland, with Pastor Tim Ricker officiating. Mrs. Fish died Sunday, October 30, 1994, at her home near Wheatland.
