

Mary Betty Fish

April 24, 1913– August 28, 2006

At her request no funeral services were held for Mary Betty Fish, 93, who died August 28, 2006 in Denver. Her ashes were interred at the Wheatland Cemetery.

Ms Fish, born April 24, 1913 was the adopted daughter of Blanche and Dr. Charles E. Fish. She attended Wheatland schools graduating from Wheatland High School in 1932. She then attended Stephens College in Columbia, Mo., where she majored in music. Following graduation she attended the University of Wyoming where she was a member of Pi Phi Sorority and received a B.A. degree in music.

Betty spent the rest of her life in Denver where she had her own music studio and kept in touch with many of her students over the years. She served as church organist for most of her adult life. During WWII she played piano regularly at the Lowrey Field U.S.O.

An avid baseball fan, she frequently attended games of the Denver Bears and later the Rockies.

Betty is survived by second cousins Betty Jane Gano of Hayden, Idaho, Shirley Jean and husband Don Fancher of Denver, Elizabeth and husband Louis Schilt of Laramie and Dr Charles Fish and wife Meellee of Rochester, Minn.
