

FISHER, NANNIE
1870-May 3, 1916

Mrs. A.W. Fisher died quite suddenly this morning from acute dilation of the heart. Mrs. Fisher had been suffering for over three years from an abdominal tumor of a serious nature, for which she had unsuccessfully been treated at many places in the east, prior to moving to Wheatland. Her condition becoming critical, she was brought to the hospital last week. Dr. I.B. Perkins of Denver was called in consultation and to assist in the delicate operation, which was performed on Sunday. The patient rallied nicely from the operation and appeared to be gaining strength every hour until this morning when she was suddenly stricken with the heart trouble mentioned and died in a very short time. Deceased was 46 years of age, and had a son and daughter, both married and living in this community. Mr. and Mrs. Fisher came here 18 months ago from Illinois.
