

FITZ, FRED A.
August 1, 1860-January 13, 1914

Died, at his home in Wheatland, Friday evening, Jan. 13, 1914, Fred A. Fitz, aged 53 years.

Mr. Fitz was born in Cambridge, Mass., Aug. 1, 1860, but in early life chose to cast his fortunes with the west and located at Cheyenne in the frontier days where he resided until five years ago when he came to Wheatland and established a furniture store. Some years ago his wife passed to the other shore, leaving to his care, an only daughter, Miss Bessie Fitz, who is now deputy clerk of this county. For the past few years, he had been a constant sufferer from dropsy and heart trouble, hence the end was not unexpected. Through all his suffering, he maintained a cheerful, amiable disposition and faced the inevitable with calm resignation. A brother, Chas. Fitz of Cheyenne, was here to attend the funeral, which occurred Thursday afternoon, Rev. R.F. Paxton officiating, and the body was laid to rest in the Wheatland cemetery.
