

FLETCHER, ELIZABETH PATRICK
December 25, 1900-December 9, 1927

Mrs. Elizabeth Patrick-Fletcher, wife of Fred L. Fletcher, died in Wheatland, Friday, December 9th, after taking suddenly ill Wednesday.

Mrs. Fletcher was one of the prominent ladies of Cottonwood community having lived here the past ten years and leaves a large host of friends to mourn her death.

Funeral services were held at the Methodist church, on Tuesday, December 13th, and burial was made in the Wheatland cemetery with the Watson Mortuary in charge.

Elizabeth Patrick-Fletcher, daughter of John and Anna Patrick was born December 25th in Lost Creek, Iowa. She came to Wyoming in 1917 which has been her home since.

In 1919, she was united in marriage to Fred L. Fletcher. Of this union, two children were born, Elizabeth and a babe which died in infancy.

Her father, John Patrick, preceded her to the spirit land in 1907.

She leaves to mourn her departure, her husband and one daughter, Elizabeth, her mother, Mrs. Anna Patrick of Chicago, a sister, Mrs. Seock of Whitney, Ind., John and Joe Patrick of Albia, Iowa, Miss Anna Patrick of Des Moines, Iowa, Mrs. Tillie Westwick, Mrs. Emma Dixon, both of Wheatland, Mrs. Hugh Johnson, Kellough, Idaho, Miss Verna Patrick of Wheatland.

She was of a cheerful happy disposition and was held in high esteem by all who knew her and enjoyed the companionship of a multitude of friends.
