

MRS. FORMAN PASSES AWAY

Mrs. Teco F. Foreman, of Wheatland passed away Tuesday morning after an extended illness.

The Foreman came to Guernsey in 1914 and resided here for many years where Mrs. Foreman had many friends.

She had been confined to the hospital off and on for the past two months, but returned to her home on June 27th and was able to be about here home, until early Tuesday morning when her condition became worse and she was again taken to the hospital where she passed away.

Mrs. Foreman was born in McClouth, Kansas, June 27, 1890, and was 62 years old at the time of her passing. She was a member of the Congregational Church and was affiliated with the Order of the Eastern Star.
