

FORWOOD, WILLIAM B.
October 19, 1888-June 24, 1953

Death came to William B. (Dick) Forwood, prominent Wheatland citizen, on Wednesday of this week at his home, following an extended illness.

Born October 19, 1888 in Forest Hill, Md., Mr. Forwood came to the Glendo community in 1918, where he lived nine years before moving to Wheatland where he has since resided. He was a retired building contractor.

He was a member of the Episcopal church of Wheatland. Services will be held at the church Saturday afternoon, June 27, with the Rt. Rev. Bishop J. Wilson Hunter of Laramie officiating at the last rites. Burial will take place in the Wheatland cemetery. The body will lie in state at the Schrader Funeral home until time of the service at 1:30 p.m.
