

FOSTER, KENNETH RODGER  
March 17, 1938-September 18, 1958

Kenneth R. Foster, 20, of Dwyer, son of Mr. and Mrs. G.A. Foster was killed around 11:45 last Thursday night a mile and a half north of Guernsey on the Hartville road, state secondary, when the south-bound 1957 Pontiac sedan rolled four or five times, broke a telephone pole and landed 697 feet from the point of leaving the highway.

According to Patrolman Jack Eddleman, Foster and his two companions, who sustained minor injuries, were all thrown clear of the vehicle, which was a complete wreck. Foster was found 15 feet in front of the car.

The accident occurred just beyond a stretch of new construction, on a curve of the road and was about a mile from the Bud Patterson house, to which Jack Joecks of Guernsey, 19, was able to make his way for assistance. He was treated at the Platte Memorial hospital for head injuries and was dismissed Monday, September 22.

The other occupant, Walter Elmore, 21, of Guernsey, incurred head cuts, bruises and a broken leg and managed to crawl to the ditch after the accident. He was taken Sunday to Cheyenne for hospitalization.
