

FOSTER, THEODORE OTTO
June 29, 1902-August 28, 1967

Rev. Theodore Otto Foster, minister of the All Saints Episcopal Church, passed away Monday, Aug. 28, at the Platte County Memorial Hospital after a brief illness. Coming to Wheatland from Lusk, he had served the Episcopal parish for the past two years.

Rev. Foster was born in Munich, Germany June 29, 1902. He was a graduate of St. Thomas Seminary of Denver, Colo., and a graduate of Church Divinity School of Pacific at Berkeley, Calif. He served as a missionary in the interior of China for 11 years, and served parishes at Benicia, Calif., Appleton, Minn. and Lusk, Wyo. He spoke seven languages.

He was affiliated with the Episcopal Church, the AF & AM (Lusk), Royal Neighbors of America, OES (Lusk, Wyo.) and was a past Patron of the OES at Manville.

He is survived by his wife, Clara Foster, Wheatland; one daughter, Mrs. Julie Sorrells, Denver, Colo.; four grandchildren; and one brother, Josef, in Germany.

Funeral services were held from the Episcopal Church Wednesday, Aug. 30. At 11:00 a.m. Officiating were the Right Rev. James Wilson Hunter, Bishop of Wyoming, Rev. Stanley Guille and Rev. Allan Cheales. Interment was in the Wheatland cemetery.

Serving as pallbearers were Rev. Raymond Clark, Rev. Howard Wilson, Rev. Ware King, Rev. Ernest Williams, Rev. Eugene Todd, and Rev. Dean Foley.
