She died Thursday, March 9, 2006, at Platte County Memorial Nursing Home in Wheatland.

Edna was born Dec. 13, 1910, in Gorham, Kans., the daughter of Lydia (Jordan) and Jacob Musselman. The family moved to Wheatland where she met her husband, Claude Albert Foulk and they were married Feb. 20, 1931, in Wheatland. Claude loved the outdoors; working on different ranches in Wyoming; and, Edna, the perfect helpmate, was by his side, doing the cooking and even driving the team of horses if needed. She could do anything. In the late 1940's they opened the Western Shop in Wheatland and Claude was the shoe cobbler. In the 1950's, they purchased El Rancho Restaurant north of Wheatland, and life took on a new meaning. They served the people and this is what

Edna loved. In 1981, they sold the business and moved into Wheatland. Edna was confirmed in the Lutheran Church at the age of 12. In 1990, Edna received the Outstanding Homemaker Award in Platte County.

Survivors include a brother, John Musselman of Benson, Ariz., and numerous nieces and nephews

She was preceded in death by her parents; husband, Claude on March 8, 2001; twin sons at birth, Leon and Leo and another son, Doval Laverne Foulk in 1936; four brothers, Eitel, Edward, George, and Gus Musselman; and three sisters, Martha Bruntz, Lydia Brown, and Alice Morton.
