Funeral liturgy for Debora Lynn Francis, 50, were celebrated Saturday, November 22, 2008, at Saint Patrick Catholic Church in Wheatland, Wyoming, with Father Jan Santich as the celebrant. Cremation has taken place.

She died Tuesday, November 18, 2008, at the Wyoming Medical Center in Casper, Wyoming.
