

FREEMAN, GEORGE ANDREW  
July 28, 1903-November 23, 1934

George Andrew Freeman, 31 year old Wheatland resident, passed away here Friday morning from pneumonia. He had been ill for about six days and while his condition was serious from the first, the end came as a distinct shock to his many friends.

George was born at Pueblo, Colo., July 28, 1903. He had been a resident of Wheatland for the past 30 years. At the time of his death, he was 31 years, 3 months and 25 days of age.

Besides his widow of about a year, Helen Harris Freeman, he is survived by his mother, Mrs. Frank Howard; eight sisters, Mrs. M.R. Williams, Mrs. Chas. H. Nelson, Mrs. A.C. Haeberle, Mrs. Lyle Clay, Faye Sornberger, all of Wheatland, Mrs. Allie Sloanaker of St. Helens, Ore., Mrs. Don Kirby, Watsonville, Calif., and Mrs. Harold Loomis of Wheatland; two brothers, Tom Freeman, Peoria, Ill., and Bernie Freeman of Wheatland. One sister, Mrs. John Payne, preceded him in death. All were present for the funeral with the exception of Mrs. Sloanaker and Mrs. Kirby.

Funeral services were held Sunday afternoon at 2 o'clock from the Congregational church with Rev. Dwight M. Kitch in charge of the services. Interment was made in the Wheatland cemetery with the Copley Funeral Home in charge of arrangements.
