

## Former Wheatland Resident Dies in Arizona Thursday

The many friends and relatives of Mrs. Wm. Frick were surprised to learn the sad news of her death in Phoenix, Ariz., on January 23rd.

Mr. and Mrs. Frick were former residents of the Wheatland community, coming here from Oklahoma and residing for about 6 years on their farm, east of Wheatland. They left here about 2 years ago for Arizona in hopes that the climate there would benefit her health. While Mrs. Frick's health has been poor for some time, her condition was not considered serious, and her demise was a shock to all who knew her.

Funeral services were held from the Wheatland Methodist church, on Tuesday afternoon, the services in charge of Rev. Orman C. King with Rev. Chas F. Thomas, assisting. Burial was made in the Wheatland cemetery in charge of the Longwith-Richards Funeral Home.

Annie Huffman was born September 20th, 1867 in the State of Missouri. She was the daughter of Isaiah and Sarah Huffman and the youngest of five children, two brothers preceding her in death. In August 1921 she was married to W. A. Frick and aside from her husband she is survived by two sisters, Mrs. J. A. Carmichael of Dwyer and Mrs. J. T. Hanna of Chugwater.
