

Wheatland, July 15, 1966 will be held Wednesday, July 16, at 11 A.M. in the United Church of Christ with Rev. O.O. Natwick officiating.

Gertrude Fritz was born in Valentine, Neb., Dec. 21, 1907, the daughter of Charles and Effie Anderson.
