

FULK, ISAAC C.  
February 28, 1870-March 7, 1965

Isaac C. Fulk, a resident of the area since 1919, succumbed in the Platte county Memorial Hospital, March 7, 1965 after a lengthy illness. Mr. Fulk was born in Newcastle Ind. on February 28, 1870. He was a farmer before his retirement.

Services were conducted by Rev. Clifford Polson at the Schrader Chapel on March 8 at 2:00 p.m. with William Sutherland, Sam Edmiston, Ted Schaffner, Harold Garrett, Frank Rumsey and Harry Linton serving as pallbearers. Interment was in the Wheatland cemetery.
