

FULK, MATTIE REBECCA GREENE

July 5, 1869-May 6, 1942

Funeral services were held from the Watson and Dennis Chapel Saturday afternoon, May 9, for Mattie Rebecca Fulk, who passed away Wednesday afternoon, May 6, at her home in Wheatland. Rev. C.B. Doughty was in charge of the services. She was seventy-one years and ten months old and had resided in Wheatland and community the past twenty-three years.

Mrs. Fulk was born July 5, 1869 in Burton, Genesse County, Michigan. She was united in marriage to Isaac C. Fulk on December 17, 1892 in Armour, South Dakota. Mr. and Mrs. Fulk moved to Wheatland from Scottsbluff, Nebraska.
