

GALLEGOS, MARY JANE BAROS
April 7, 1917-May 8, 1974

Funeral services for Mary Jane Gallegos were scheduled for Friday, May 10th at 10:00 a.m. Services were conducted by Monsignor F.J. Kimmell at St. Patrick's Church, Wheatland, with rosary services being held Thursday evening at 7:30 p.m. at the Schrader Chapel.
